Methodology

This study was conducted online among a representative sample of respondents aged 18 years and older.

- The sample comprises 1,033 respondents, distributed throughout Australia including both capital city and non-capital city areas.
- Quotas were applied based on age, gender and region to ensure the sample reflected the broader population.
- YouGov Galaxy designed the questionnaire.
- Fieldwork commenced on Tuesday 7 May and was completed on Friday 10 May, 2019.
- Following the completion of interviewing, the data was weighted by various demographic variables to reflect the latest ABS population estimates.
